Established in 1997 and located in North West Victoria's Mallee region, Mallee Track Health and Community Service is a Multi Purpose Service that provides acute medical and urgent care, community and district nursing; high & low level residential aged care; long day care; vacation care; kindergarten cluster management and a broad range of allied health services.

While there were real benefits for the community and to the individuals it serves, operating across multiple sites with distances in some instances over 250 kilometres, it was also one of their greatest challenges. With a mixture of legacy equipment and infrastructure, such as various NBN technology and private wireless networks throughout sites, this meant that there was no uniform communications across locations. This resulted in cumbersome operations with some sites using two handsets per desk for their communications needs.
